Early Years:

In 2020 no data is available due to COVID19

In 2019 79% of our pupils achieved a good level of development. Nationally 72% of pupils have achieved this

In 2018 72% of our pupils achieved a good level of development. Nationally 72% of pupils have achieved this

In 2017 77% of our pupils achieved a good level of development. Nationally 71% of pupils have achieved this

Phonics:

In 2019 83% of our Year 1 pupils achieved the expected level in the phonics screening test. Nationally, 82% achieved this standard. By the end of Y2 97% of pupils reached the expected standard.

In 2018 93% of our Year 1 pupils achieved the expected level in the phonics screening test. Nationally, 82% achieved this standard. By the end of Y2 94% of pupils reached the expected standard.

In 2017 87% of our Year 1 pupils achieved the expected level in the phonics screening test. Nationally, 81% achieved this standard. By the end of Y2 90% of pupils reached the expected standard.

Key Stage 1 results 2019:

83% of our pupils achieved the expected standard in Reading (compared to 75% nationally). 17% achieved the greater depth standard, (compared to 25% nationally)

77% of our pupils achieved the expected standard in Writing (compared to 69% nationally). 13% achieved the greater depth standard, compared to 15% nationally)

80% of our pupils achieved the expected standard in Mathematics (compared to 76% nationally). 13% achieved the greater depth standard, (compared to 22% nationally)

Key Stage 1 results 2018:

80% of our pupils achieved the expected standard in Reading. 33% achieved the greater depth standard

74% of our pupils achieved the expected standard in Writing. 17% achieved the greater depth standard

86% of our pupils achieved the expected standard in Mathematics. 23% achieved the greater depth standard

Key Stage 1 results 2017:

77% of our pupils achieved the expected standard in Reading. 23% achieved the greater depth standard

73% of our pupils achieved the expected standard in Writing. 7% achieved the greater depth standard

77% of our pupils achieved the expected standard in Mathematics. 23% achieved the greater depth standard

Key Stage 2 results 2019:

70% of our pupils achieved the expected standard in Reading (compared to 73% nationally). 37% achieved the greater depth standard (compared to 27% nationally)

87% of our pupils achieved the expected standard in Writing (compared to 78% nationally). 10% achieved the greater depth standard (compared to 20% nationally)

83% of our pupils achieved the expected standard in Mathematics (compared to 79% nationally). 10% achieved the greater depth standard (compared to 27% nationally)

63% of our pupils achieved the expected standard in Reading, Writing and Mathematics combined (compared to 65% nationally). 7% achieved the greater depth standard (compared to 11% nationally)

Our progress measures for 2019 were Reading (+0.15), Writing (-1.29) and Mathematics (-1.9)

Key Stage 2 results 2018:

77% of our pupils achieved the expected standard in Reading (compared to 75% nationally). 20% achieved the greater depth standard (compared to 28% nationally)

83% of our pupils achieved the expected standard in Writing (compared to 78% nationally). 10% achieved the greater depth standard (compared to 20% nationally)

70% of our pupils achieved the expected standard in Mathematics (compared to 76% nationally). 23% achieved the greater depth standard (compared to 24% nationally)

60% of our pupils achieved the expected standard in Reading, Writing and Mathematics combined (compared to 64% nationally). 10% achieved the greater depth standard (compared to 10% nationally)

Our progress measures for 2017 were Reading (-2.43), Writing (-1.52) and Mathematics (-1.04)

Key Stage 2 results 2017:

83% of our pupils achieved the expected standard in Reading (compared to 71% nationally). 43% achieved the greater depth standard (compared to 19% nationally)

93% of our pupils achieved the expected standard in Writing (compared to 76% nationally). 20% achieved the greater depth standard (compared to 15% nationally)

83% of our pupils achieved the expected standard in Mathematics (compared to 75% nationally). 23% achieved the greater depth standard (compared to 17% nationally)

73% of our pupils achieved the expected standard in Reading, Writing and Mathematics combined (compared to 61% nationally). 17% achieved the greater depth standard (compared to 5% nationally)

Our progress measures for 2017 were Reading (+2.1), Writing (+0.3) and Mathematics (-1.1)
